Scam Alert

Veterans should be aware of a marketing scam targeting callers trying to reach the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) National Call Center or GI Bill Call Center. A marketing company has established two fraudulent numbers that differ from the two official VA call center numbers by one digit. If the fraudulent number is dialed by mistake, the answering party will offer a gift card and try to obtain personal and financial information, including credit card information from the caller. The answering party may even transfer the caller to the VA after the caller's information is obtained. The numbers to be avoided are: 800-872-1000 (the National Call Center number is 800-827-1000) and 888-442-4511 (the VA GI Bill Call Center is 888-442-4551).

A member of Post 96 has also reported receiving calls from cell phones with a caller ID which indicates Washington DC, soliciting money for veterans. He has checked out the numbers and they are not a valid organization. They appear to be scam artists looking for donations over the phone. Any donations should be done by mail and obviously to a valid veteran's organization. One of the caller ID's was 202-779-9332.

Veterans can now have their status recognized on drivers' licenses, state issued ID cards

The DMV and AAA offices on January 2, 2013 began issuing drivers' licenses and ID cards that include the symbol of an American Flag to identify a veteran status.

For inclusion on a drivers' or state issued ID card, veterans must submit an application at least 30 days prior to visiting a DMV or AAA office. A completed application and proof of honorable discharge, such as a DD-214, must be submitted to the state Department of Veterans' Affairs (CT DVA). The CT DVA will verify the veteran's military status and electronically notify DMV of the request prior to the driver's license or ID card being issued. The application can be downloaded online at www.ct.gov/ctva under the "Application for

Veteran's Flag" link. The flag symbol will be added to veteran's license or ID card at no additional cost at renewal time or when it is first issued.
