

COMMMANDER CONLIN ENERGIZES THE POST'S P.R. EFFORT! Concurrent with the appointment of Harold Ducey as Post Historian, Commander Conlin assigned him the additional duty as Public Affairs Officer and asked Ducey to work with Sr. Vice Commander Moe Fradette to publicize a fundraiser for the 143rd MP Company's Family Support Center. The 143rd is a West Hartford based Army National Guard unit and is scheduled for imminent deployment. The Family Support Center provides a resource for the families of the deployed National Guardsmen in family emergency situations. Our P.R. team launched a media blitz that resulted in raising \$1,300+ for the 143rd Family Support Center.
